ADMISSION PROCESS:

Admission to LL.M. (One Year) programme is conducted through the following procedure:

Step 1: Apply online at symlaw.ac.in

Step 2: a. Appear for the All India Admission Test (AIAT) CBT (Centre Based Test)

b. Appear for Personal Interaction (Online PI)

Symbiosis All India Admission Test (AIAT) :-

All Admission to LL.M (One Year) is offered through Symbiosis All India Admission Test (AIAT), which will take place in a Centre Based Test (CBT) mode at select test centres across India. (The list of test centres may be found in the AIAT Registration Portal) The AIAT consists of:

Written Test (CBT Mode) (comprising of objective and subjective written test to assess the aptitude for teaching, research, legal aptitude and basic legal knowledge)- Weightage 70 %

Test Duration: - 105 minutes

Personal Interview (PI) (Online) - (Personal Interview is intended to test the personal Attributes, Fitment, Work Experience, Publications and Statement of Purpose)- Weightage 30%.

PI Duration: - 10 minutes (approx.).

Structure of AIAT Computer Based Test (Total time: 105 Minutes)

i. Writing Ability Test (15*2=30 Marks): Two Subjective questions for 15 marks each. Duration for written test is 65 minutes.

ii. MCQs (2*20=40 marks): 20 objective questions for 2 marks each. Duration for MCQs is 40 minutes.

Candidate will be selected for final merit on the basis of cumulative score of performance in the:

a) AIAT Computer Based Test: 70 Marks

b) Online Personal Interaction (PI): 30 marks.

Declaration of Merit List: Merit lists will be declared on our website www.symlaw.ac.in as per the schedule.

Syllabus for AIAT:

Syllabus for AIAT Computer Based Test: It will comprise of objective (MCQ) and subjective written test to assess the teaching aptitude, research aptitude, legal aptitude and basic legal knowledge. It includes questions from the following areas: Research Methodology, Legal Reasoning, Legal Aptitude, Jurisprudence, Constitutional Law, IPC, Public International Law, Human Rights, Corporate Law (Contract Act, Companies Act etc.), Family Law and Environmental Law.

Verification of Educational Qualification Documents and Eligibility:

Candidates need to furnish their educational qualification documents as per the directions of SLS Pune/SIU for verification at the time of appearing for the AIAT. If any candidate fails to furnish the documents at the time of appearing for the AIAT for verification the candidate will not be permitted to appear for the AIAT. Further, the candidates, who are shortlisted in the merit list after the AIAT, need to submit a list of documents to acquire eligibility to be admitted to the LL.M. Programme at Symbiosis Law School, Pune. If the candidate does not submit the document for eligibility purposes, admission of the same candidate stands cancelled.

Note: You are requested to bring a Statement of Purpose (SOP) not more than (250 words) and one reference (one page each) from the Head or Supervisor of your Institute at the time of appearing for the PI. It will be verified as a part of the document verification process.

Refund Policy
